Breast Cancer Survivors to Put on a Show at Maimonides' 14th Annual Pink Runway: A Celebration of Survivorship, Strength, and Community

WHAT:

Maimonides Health will host its 14th annual Pink Runway at the historic Weylin in Williamsburg. This signature event honors breast cancer survivors who will take to the runway in a moving tribute to healing and resilience. Proceeds from this year's event will go directly to the Maimonides Breast Cancer Center to fund essential imaging equipment, enabling a 20% expansion in diagnostic capacity so that more patients can receive timely, life-saving screenings and treatment. The event will be co-hosted by actor, host, and author **Steve Schirripa**, best known for his starring roles on **The Sopranos** and **Blue Bloods**.

The evening will also celebrate **Jodi Pollack**, Sotheby's Chairman and Co-Worldwide Head of 20th Century Design as well as Chairman of Major Collections, with the prestigious **Wings of Healing Award** for her leadership, dedication, and advocacy on behalf of breast cancer patients. **Victoria Imperioli**, director, producer, and long-time wife to **Michael Imperioli**, will also be in attendance.
